





Healthcare

Cris contra el cáncer Foundation

We collaborate in the “DAME 5 MÁS” challenge, aimed at promoting research into metastatic cancer and a specific project dedicated to childhood cancer. This initiative reached the Foundation thanks to the involvement of a Sacyr employee who brought the cause to our attention.



Spanish Association Against Cancer (AECC)


We collaborate with the AECC (Spanish Association Against Cancer) on psychological support activities, training workshops, and informational sessions focused on prevention and support for patients and their families. Additionally, we organize charity markets at Sacyr’s headquarters, dedicating the proceeds to the association’s programs.





Aspace Navarra

We have collaborated with Aspace Navarra in the SAOR project, an initiative that offers support to young people with cerebral palsy and other disabilities in their daily lives through specialized therapies and the Petö method. The center in Navarra is a pioneer in Spain in applying this approach, which contributes to improving the autonomy and quality of life of the participants.



Sant Joan de Déu Foundation

We support the Sant Joan de Déu Foundation to advance pediatric cancer therapies that yield superior results and lower toxicity. This collaboration was initiated by Sacyr employees undertaking a master's program at the EOI, thereby reinforcing our commitment to initiatives championed by our own team.



Purple Warriors Association

We have collaborated with the Purple Warriors Association by participating in their 7th-anniversary charity dinner, aimed at promoting research into rare diseases affecting children with neurological and metabolic conditions. Our involvement helps to raise awareness of these diseases and support the families living with them.



Institute for Research in Biomedicine (IRB Barcelona)

We collaborate with IRB Barcelona to promote research projects focused on metastasis and new medical applications that advance the search for more effective cancer treatments. This collaboration reinforces our commitment to science and to initiatives that contribute to progress in global health.



Foundation for Children's Health of the Valencian Community

We collaborate with the Foundation for Children's Health of the Valencian Community on support programs aimed at newborns with high-risk factors, both biological in origin and those arising from vulnerable social situations. Our contribution facilitates specialized therapies and treatments that promote their proper development and well-being from the first months of life.

Contigo Foundation

We are collaborating with the Contigo Foundation on the PHENIX project, which aims to ensure that over 90% of the 180 participating patients to remain disease-free at a molecular level after two years of follow-up without treatment. This project represents a significant advance in research and improving the quality of life for women with breast cancer.





Musicians for health

We collaborate with Musicians for Health (Músicos por la Salud) to deliver four micro-concerts for patients in hospital settings: two at the Hospital de Parla and two at the Hospital de Coslada. These musical encounters aim to enhance the emotional well-being of patients during their hospital stay.

Down Madrid

We collaborate in various corporate volunteer activities aimed at employees and their families, including horseback riding sessions, ceramics workshops, visits to Faunia, climbing wall activities, and participation in the Down Madrid charity race, for which 50 bib numbers were provided. These initiatives foster inclusion and interaction between individuals with and without intellectual disabilities.



Step by Step Foundation

We collaborate with Step by Step Foundation to facilitate the participation of individuals with disabilities in the All-Terrain Rally/Bajas experience, a pioneering initiative in Spain that allows them to experience these types of non-competitive events firsthand. This collaboration promotes inclusion and full participation in adapted leisure and adventure activities.



Autism Avila

We participated in the Autism Awareness Day event, a gathering that brings together families, professionals, users, and the general public from the province of Ávila. The objective of this activity is to promote understanding of autism and raise awareness about the needs and support required by individuals on the spectrum.



A toda vela

We collaborate with A Toda Vela on their holiday program designed for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities in the city of Almería. This initiative promotes autonomy, inclusive leisure, and the full social participation of its participants.





Spinal Cord Injury Foundation

We collaborate with the Spinal Cord Injury Foundation (Fundación Lesionado Medular), supporting their pediatric rehabilitation scholarship program aimed at families in socio-economic vulnerability. Furthermore, our work received public recognition from the President of the Community of Madrid, Isabel Díaz Ayuso, in appreciation of Sacyr's commitment to inclusion and improving the quality of life for children with spinal cord injuries.



A la Par Foundation

The A la Par Foundation participated in one of our weRSoCial gatherings, a series of internal talks aimed at raising awareness among Sacyr professionals. During this session, insights were shared into the daily lives of individuals with intellectual disabilities and their family environments. The speakers were a mother and her son with a disability, a representative from the organization, and a colleague from their Special Employment Center, who offered a close and realistic perspective on the challenges and strengths of inclusion.



ONCE Foundation

We collaborate with the ONCE Foundation through an activity of Sacyr's Sports Club, which featured Marta Arce, a judoka, 5th Dan black belt, Paralympic medalist in Athens, Beijing, London, and Paris, and the flag bearer for the Spanish team at the Paris Paralympic Games. Her testimony and sporting experience contributed to raising awareness and inspiring our employees regarding inclusion and personal achievement.

Talisman Association

We collaborate with the Talismán Association, supporting its training activities aimed at individuals with disabilities. Additionally, we participated in a corporate volunteering day alongside EY, fostering practical learning, inclusion, and teamwork in a natural and accessible environment.

Emalaikat Foundation

We collaborated with the Emalaikat Foundation on the installation of a solar-powered water pump for the Nakwamunyen community. This initiative aims to ensure access to quality water for consumption, livestock care, and the development of agricultural projects that enhance local nutrition.

Additionally, we conducted **two corporate volunteering trips in Turkana, Kenya**, in May and November. During these trips, Sacyr employees gained firsthand insight into the region's needs and supported various initiatives focused on water access, education, and improving the community's living conditions.

Nazareth Association

We collaborate with the Nazaret Association on their summer camps, which are aimed at children from families at risk of social exclusion, providing spaces for leisure, coexistence, and educational support.

Furthermore, we participated in the Christmas gift campaign for elderly individuals hospitalized in Parla and Coslada, helping to accompany them during the holidays.



Colisée Foundation

We collaborate with the Colisée Foundation on the rehabilitation of Dolores' home. Dolores is an elderly resident of Paiporta who was severely affected by the floods caused by the heavy rains in Valencia. This intervention allowed us to improve her living conditions and ensure a safe and habitable environment after the emergency.

Horizontes Abiertos

We collaborate with Horizontes Abiertos (Open Horizons) to provide healthcare and psychological support to vulnerable individuals. Additionally, we conducted a corporate volunteering activity with Sacyr employees and organized a weRSocial session focused on addiction prevention and awareness, fostering knowledge within the company.



Educo

We collaborate with Educo to provide psychological support, training, and essential materials to teachers and children affected by the heavy rains in Alfafar, Valencia. This collaboration contributes to the emotional and educational recovery of the school community following a climatic emergency that significantly impacted their well-being.



Valencian Federation of People with Intellectual Disabilities (FEVADIS)

We collaborate with FEVADIS for the acquisition of tablets, which have enabled their team of therapists to optimize their work, facilitating the care and monitoring of individuals with intellectual disabilities they support. This technological improvement contributes to strengthening their intervention processes and offering more effective and tailored support.



Food Bank

We collaborate with the Food Bank in collecting oil and in various food drives throughout the year, particularly strengthening our participation during Christmas. Furthermore, we received recognition from its president in gratitude for Sacyr's commitment and involvement in supporting the families most in need.





Elena Barraquer Foundation

We collaborate with the Elena Barraquer Foundation on the “NoMásCataratas” (No More Cataracts) project, a surgical and community initiative that restores sight to approximately 500 people with cataracts in disadvantaged countries. This action immediately improves the quality of life for patients and strengthens ophthalmic care in the communities where it is implemented.



Vihda Association

We participate in the school sanitation project in Kimiri, Kenya, aimed at improving hygiene conditions and access to basic infrastructure to prevent transmissible diseases and promote safe and healthy school environments. This initiative directly contributes to the well-being of the educational community and the development of sustainable hygiene habits.



Manos de Ayuda Social Foundation

We collaborate with Manos de Ayuda Social Foundation in the development of the programs that are carried out in their community kitchen, aimed at offering food, social care and employment guidance to people in vulnerable situations. In addition, Sacyr employees participate on a recurring basis **one Monday a month** to support the tasks of the canteen and meal prep.



UPlanet

We collaborated with UPlanet in the transfer to Mauritania and the commissioning of a containerized pilot desalination plant, previously located in Almería. This initiative aims to improve access to water in communities with limited resources.

Additionally, a corporate volunteering trip took place in March, involving five Sacyr employees who supported the installation efforts and raised awareness about sustainable water use.



Colombia

Buga Improves educational infrastructure San Pedro Claver

We collaborated on the construction and improvement of the San Pedro Claver Educational Institution, with particular attention to the General Carlos Albán campus in the Juntas district (Dagua). This initiative has strengthened the educational center's facilities and fostered a safer and more suitable environment for student learning.



Buga Desks with history recycled material

We strengthened the educational environments of the road corridor by providing desks made with recycled materials, promoting environmental sustainability and the circular economy. With this initiative, we improved learning conditions in institutions with limited resources and fostered environmental awareness, contributing to the educational and social development of rural communities.





Canal del Dique Making Smiles

We developed a project aimed at providing comprehensive care to children with cleft lip and palate, with the aim of improving their quality of life through timely medical and therapeutic interventions. This initiative contributes to their physical, emotional and social well-being, facilitating specialized support throughout the recovery process.



Canal del Dique Upgrades in Evitar Township

We enhanced the technological and pedagogical capabilities of the computer lab to strengthen learning and promote the appropriate use of digital tools among students. We procured and delivered 20 computer units, suitable furniture, and basic one-year licenses, and we conduct periodic monitoring of the equipment's operation and condition.



Chile



Ruta del Elqui Mi Parque Foundation

We contributed to improving this community's quality of life through the creation of inclusive green spaces, fostering coexistence, community use, and the well-being of residents. This initiative has also strengthened our relationship with the local community, promoting a more sustainable and participatory environment.



Ruta de la Fruta Mi Parque Foundation

We promote the creation of inclusive green spaces to improve the quality of life of the community located in section A of Ruta de la Fruta. This project has strengthened our bond with the local community and has fostered safer, more accessible, and suitable environments for coexistence and social development.



Peru



Aldeas Infantiles Cajamarca Pachacútec Community Home

We collaborated on improving the conditions of the Pachacútec Community Home by waterproofing the roofs of its four residences designated for minors, which were showing significant deterioration. This intervention contributed to ensuring safer and more adequate spaces for their protection and well-being.



Ayuda en Acción Artistic workshops development of soft skills

We promoted empowerment, peaceful coexistence and social integration through the Arts for Integration program, which gave workshops in four artistic disciplines. This initiative strengthened children's learning, communication skills and social inclusion, promoting them as agents of change in their communities. The project was developed in two state educational institutions in San Martín de Porres district.



Paraguay



Schools in Asunción

We carried out upgrade and adaptation works at the Maká Quemkuket Indigenous School, improving both its infrastructures and the water supply systems. This intervention ensured optimal conditions of safety, health and well-being for the entire educational community.

United States



El Rastrillo 305, 204 Miami

We attended this charity event, that combined live music, gastronomy, and cultural activities, serving as a space for gathering, community engagement, and social awareness. The event was aimed at people of all ages and nationalities, fostering participation and support for social causes within the Miami community.



Grace Campus Texas

We collaborate with Grace Campus Texas to facilitate access to basic resources and provide transitional shelter for six months to homeless individuals. The objective is to support them on their path toward an independent life and their full inclusion in society. This program offers guidance, stability, and opportunities for them to rebuild their lives.

Cancer Association of Louisiana

We collaborate with the Cancer Association of Louisiana to ensure that no patient faces difficulties accessing medical care or covering their basic needs during treatment. This initiative contributes to improving their well-being and reducing the barriers encountered by individuals affected by cancer and their families.



St. Matthew's House

We participated in the "Dean Lind Memorial Golf Classic" charity golf tournament, an initiative aimed at raising support for the social and community programs driven by St. Matthew's House for the benefit of vulnerable individuals.

Juan XXIII Foundation

We continue our collaboration with the Juan XXIII Foundation on the installation of kitchens for its culinary and hospitality school, a project that promotes the training and employability of individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities. This initiative contributes to creating more comprehensive and professional training environments, thereby facilitating their labor inclusion in the hospitality sector.





EXIT Foundation

We participated in the Coach, Explora Videos, and Speed Dating programs promoted by EXIT Foundation, all initiatives aimed at improving the socio-labor integration of young people in exclusion. These projects combine mentoring, vocational discovery, and meetings with professionals to strengthen their skills, expand their opportunities, and support them in their transition to the working world.



Red Acoge - Valencia Acoge

We collaborate with Valencia Acoge, an organization part of the Red Acoge network, on a project supporting foreign individuals who, following the heavy rains, found themselves in a particularly vulnerable situation. This initiative provides social support, guidance, and basic resources to facilitate their recovery and ensure appropriate attention to their needs.



DogPoint Association

A Sacyr family is participating in the temporary fostering program for a future assistance dog, accompanying it during its first year of life. Following training and instruction period, these dogs will be provided to families with children with ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder), thereby contributing to improving their autonomy, safety, and emotional well-being.



Abracadabra

We organized two magic performances with magicians from Abracadabra at the hospitals in Parla and Coslada, in Madrid, to brighten patients' stays. Additionally, we conducted two family activities with their magicians: one during Sports Day with the Sacyr Sports Club and another at the Christmas event organized by the Marketing department.



Acogida Foundation

We support the project “Esta es tu casa” (“This is your home”), a shared housing initiative for three vulnerable single-mother families. They receive comprehensive support for 18 months, guided by a personal and economic autonomy plan.



Adopt a Grandparent

We collaborate on various corporate volunteering activities, such as “Mi abuelo es la caña” (My Grandfather is awesome), recurrent calls to accompany elderly individuals, and a showcooking event where we prepared arepas alongside a “grandma chef.” These initiatives foster intergenerational bonds and combat unwanted loneliness.





Ande Foundation

We renovated the garden of the Ande Foundation in an activity carried out alongside Sacyr volunteers and the foundation's own users, fostering inclusion and collaborative work. Additionally, the Foundation has participated in several charity markets organized at Sacyr's headquarters.



Jero García Foundation

We collaborate on the Sport vs Bullying project, an initiative that utilizes boxing as an educational tool to prevent and eradicate school bullying. Additionally, we conducted a volunteering activity in which Sacyr employees and their families participated, reinforcing values of respect, coexistence, and self-esteem among the children involved.



Dialogues Foundation

We participated in the "Together4Integration" charity race, an initiative that promotes coexistence, inclusion, and civic participation through sport.



SIFU Foundation

We collaborated on the SuperArte program, an initiative that fosters the artistic talent of over 100 individuals with disabilities through music and dance, promoting their inclusion and visibility within the cultural sphere.



ELA-Spain European Association Against Leukodystrophies

We supported the “Arriluze Txallenge” project, a charity challenge that involves swimming approximately 3,000 meters between Getxo Marina and Ereaga Beach, with the aim of raising awareness and supporting the fight against leukodystrophies.

Araya Autism Foundation

We supported the acquisition of tablets, which are used as dynamic communicators through Arasaac’s free Asterics Grid program, thereby facilitating communication and learning for the center’s users in the spectrum.





Bobath Foundation

We collaborate with Bobath Foundation to strengthen its therapeutic capabilities through the incorporation of innovative equipment and support for the necessary resources to improve the mobility and balance of young people with cerebral palsy or related conditions. Among these improvements, we contributed to the acquisition of a pediatric exoskeleton, which expands rehabilitation possibilities and promotes the motor development of the children treated at the center.



Southern Foundation Baby Despensa

We participate in the “Baby Pantry” project in Madrid and Valencia, a program that distributes milk, baby food, and diapers weekly to vulnerable families. Additionally, we conducted a milk collection drive at Sacyr’s offices to support the initiative and extend its reach.



Jaime Alonso Abruña Foundation

We collaborated on the refurbishment of the 7th-floor pediatric transplant unit at La Paz University Hospital (Madrid), with the aim of creating a more humane and welcoming environment for hospitalized children. This intervention helps minors and their families experience their stay in a warmer, more familiar way, adapted to their emotional and well-being needs.

BECAUSE THEY LIVE Foundation

We collaborate on the “Llenando la vida de vida” (Filling Life with Life) project, an at-home palliative care program that supports children with serious illnesses and their families, offering comprehensive support and improves their well-being in a familiar and safe environment.



Theodora Foundation

Participating in the ‘Vivir+’ program, our ‘Smile Doctors’ conduct in-person visits to hospitalized children. In total, we carried out 8 visits to the hospitals in Parla and Coslada, with 4 interventions at each center, offering moments of joy, emotional support, and play to children and their families during their hospital stay.



Blas Méndez Ponce Foundation

We support the “La sonrisa del sol” (The Sun’s Smile) project, which aims to improve the quality of life for children and adolescents undergoing oncological treatment or suffering from other hard-to-cure pathologies. This is achieved through leisure and recreational activities that strengthen their self-esteem, confidence, and emotional management.





Golfin Foundation

We collaborate with the Golfin Foundation in their shelters and transitional housing for single mothers with children who are in highly vulnerable situations and with very limited resources. We offer them a safe space and support to progress towards greater stability and autonomy.



Save the Children

We collaborate on the summer camp program aimed at children and young people in vulnerable situations, offering them safe leisure spaces, mentorship, and socio-educational support during the summer period.




La Frontera Social Association

We collaborate on the project “School and Family Mediation in the Prevention of School Absenteeism,” whose objective is to offer personalized attention to minors from particularly vulnerable groups, promoting their straying in school and strengthening support for their families.



UCM University for Seniors' Intergenerational Solidarity Network

We collaborate with UCM's University for Seniors to support its educational activities aimed at migrant individuals, particularly Maghrebi women and recent arrivals from Sub-Saharan Africa. Furthermore, we contribute to strengthening the social fabric in the districts of Villaverde and Usera (Madrid) through academic support programs for primary and secondary school students.

Blue Life Foundation

We collaborate with Blue Life Foundation to contribute to the protection and recovery of Mediterranean marine ecosystems, especially Posidonia oceanica meadows and other species classified as vulnerable or threatened. This initiative promotes biodiversity conservation and the health of marine environments.





Buceo Melilla

We collaborated on the 9th Seabed Cleanup at Horcas Coloradas beach, an initiative that involved over 400 participants, including citizens, military personnel, and divers from the Melilla Diving Club. This effort contributed to waste removal and the protection of the marine ecosystem.



Saving the Amazon

We planted 450 trees in the Colombian Amazon forest, contributing to the reforestation of degraded areas and the recovery of native vegetation. This initiative also drives the improvement of living conditions for indigenous communities responsible for their care, strengthening their connection to the land and promoting their sustainable development.



Fieb Foundation Ethology and Biodiversity


We collaborate with the FIEB Foundation on its project for breeding and caring for endangered species, such as the European mink. The objective is to contribute to their conservation and prevent the illegal trafficking of endangered wildlife. This initiative helps protect biodiversity and maintain at-risk populations within specialized programs.

During the 4th Sacyr Foundation Week, we conducted a nest box building activity in collaboration with SEO BirdLife – Gaiambiente, in which Sacyr employees participated. This initiative promotes bird conservation and biodiversity improvement in urban and natural environments.

All funds raised during the 4th Sacyr Foundation Week were entirely allocated to research into childhood sarcoma for Cris contra el Cáncer.






Global weRSoCial
