



#### Músicos por la Salud

We put on three charity micro-concerts in the Hospital del Niño Jesús and the Hospital del Henares in the dialysis unit, psychiatric ward and in the ICU for people who are seriously ill and hospitalised.



#### Fundación Fundaz Paixena

We have been working to promote excellence in palliative care in terms of training, care and research in Zaragoza.



#### Fundación Psicología sin Fronteras

We supported psychological services to provide adequate tools for the comprehensive care of people in vulnerable situations.





#### Fundación Rementería

We collaborate with this foundation to ensure that the greatest number of people at risk of exclusion can have access to quality eye care and to combat the lack of opportunities in the Region of Madrid and in Colombia.





#### Fundación Contigo

We collaborate with this foundation to promote research projects that contribute to preventing and halting the rise of female cancer.



#### Asociación Guerreros Púrpura

We collaborated on the 6th anniversary charity dinner fundraiser to help research into rare diseases in children with neurological and metabolic disorders and diseases.



#### Asociación Autismo Granada

We offer users with ASD therapeutic intervention to promote improvements in their physical, social, emotional and cognitive functioning through psychology and speech therapy sessions and coordination with schools.



#### Fundación Blas Méndez Ponce

We support the "La sonrisa del sol" (the smiling sun) project, which aims to improve quality of life for children and teenagers undergoing cancer treatment and other pathologies that are difficult to cure, running leisure and free time activities that allow them to develop their self-esteem, confidence and emotional regulation.





#### Aspace Navarra

We contribute to improving the quality of life of children, young people and adults with cerebral palsy and that of their families through the SAOR program that provides respite, guidance and rehabilitation services to people with cerebral palsy and other related disabilities.







#### Fundación Adana

We collaborate with Fundación Adana, which promotes mental health and well-being through a WeRSoCial seminar. In this session, we address neurodiversity and neurodevelopmental disorders such as ADHD, autism, dyslexia or high capacities.







#### Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) and Asociación **Antian**

We supported UAB in its fund-raising campaign to study gene therapy for the rare genetic disease Adenylosuccinate Lyase Deficiency (ADSL), which affects around 80 children in the world.

We have continued to support the Hospital as it organises the Camino de Santiago trail for cancer patients and their professionals.





#### Fundación Freno al Ictus

We have continued to collaborate on the "Héroes en casa" (Heroes at home) project, an educational program that aims to inform and teach different groups about the importance of stroke, its symptoms, risk factors and how to act.







#### Fundación Instituto Trastornos Alimentarios – FITA

We are collaborating on a treatment grant project to create a fund to cover the total or partial cost of treatment for Eating Disorders (ED) for those people without financial aid or the resources to fund it.

#### Autismo Ávila

We have collaborated with the purchase of copies of "El autismo según Sheldon Cooper".

"La Estrella Azul", a publishing range that works with different formats, giving voice to authors with autism and to people who live with family members who have ASD, sharing the wonder of diversity and difference.





#### Asindown

We contribute to an innovative and unique project in Spain that aims to address the specific challenges of ageing faced by people with Down's syndrome and to facilitate early detection, prevention, intervention and maintenance of the symptoms of Alzheimer's associated with this stage of life.



#### FESOCE, Federación Española de Sordoceguera

We collaborate with the "Respiro Flotante" (Floating Respite) program aimed at deaf and blind people with more than 80% disability who have major support needs. A mediator together with a professional in training supervise fun alternative activities.





#### Fundación Sin Daño

We have supported the "Yes we CAN" project, which provides dog-assisted therapy as part of the neurorehabilitation treatment of children with Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) at the Hospital Infantil Universitario Niño Jesús.



#### **Inclusives**

We have collaborated in the purchase of a vehicle through the Kilómetros de Ilusiones (Kilometres of Hope) project, which allows people with disabilities from 33 different towns and villages up to 60 km away in Extremadura to attend the occupational center and day center on a daily basis.





#### Fundación AFANIAS

We have supported AFANIAS in resurfacing the access road to the Viñuelas residence in Guadalajara.



#### A toda Vela

We offer a leisure and community participation alternative for people with intellectual disabilities through the "Verano a Toda Vela" (Set Sail Summer) program, an inclusive holiday package for people with intellectual or developmental disabilities.





#### Fundación Down Madrid

We have participated in 5 activities to support the integration of people with Down's syndrome: an allotment and gardening activity, a day of horse riding, a climbing wall activity, the XIV charity race and a visit to Faunia.





#### Fundación A La Par

Over the course of the year, we collaborated on 2 activities to support the integration of people with disabilities through a Halloween party and sporting activity with zip wires and archery together with an inclusive Master Chef competition.

#### Fundación Emalaikat

We contributed to projects on education, clean drinking water and health, along with two humanitarian aid volunteering activities in Turkana (Kenya) during the months of May and November. We helped improve water and sanitation infrastructure in: Lokwakipi, Kokuselei, Riokomor and Ekipetot, Kokuselei Valley, Turkana.





#### Food Bank

We have collaborated on two campaigns to collect donations of food and basic necessities for those in need.





#### Asociación Nazaret

We collaborated on the Nazaret 2024 Summer Camp in Xàtiva (Valencia) for children aged between 5 and 14 who are at risk of social exclusion and also on the Christmas gift campaign for the Hospital Infanta Cristina in Parla and the Hospital del Henares.





#### Hogar Sí, Fundación RAIS

We have helped people who are on the streets or living in homeless shelters to rebuild their lives and their dignity by helping them get into the workplace. We help these people with basic needs, transport, etc.





#### Asociación Innicia

We have helped meet the basic needs of families in the Region of Madrid through healthy food, internet and telephone access, transport, electricity, water and gas supplies...







#### Horizontes Abiertos

Through a volunteering project, we took part in the design and implementation of a Community Garden in Las Tablas (therapeutic community), as a sustainable leisure and work reintegration activity, for people who are at severe risk of exclusion and deprived of liberty.



#### Asociación La Frontera Social

We support the "Atención de la Urgencia Social" (Social Emergency Assistance) project which aims to help people and families in situations of poverty and social vulnerability to meet their basic needs for food, clothing, hygiene and other urgent needs in Madrid and in the municipalities of Sierra Oeste, Navalagamella and Valdemorillo.



#### Cruz Roja

Thanks to the solidarity of Sacyr professionals and Sacyr Foundation, we have raised funds for those affected by storms and looding in Valencia. Sacyr Foundation doubled the amount raised by Sacyr professionals. This money was given to the Spanish Red Cross (Cruz Roja), which is working on the ground to alleviate the devastating effects of these storms. Our colleagues in the UK donated three sewage pumps to the municipality of Catarroja.

In addition, our colleagues at Sacyr Water have been working to repair high-pressure equipment damaged by the storms and also to restore the supply to homes throughout the affected area. We also sent two cleaning trucks to Paiporta to unblock the sewage system that was backed up with mud.







#### Fundación Manos de Ayuda Social

Through our monthly voluntary work, we helped out and devised menus for the soup kitchen. We also supported programs run by the organization related to food, social care and employment guidance.





#### Fundación Probono España

We offer free legal advice to third sector organizations through corporate volunteering carried out by Sacyr's lawyers.





#### Institución educativa Gabriela **Mistral**

We have improved the facilities at the Gabriela Mistral educational institution in the town of Yotoca by painting, cutting back vegetation and enhancing the facilities, developing plans and activities to reduce or mitigate the negative impacts and enhance the positive impacts on communities linked to the Project.





#### Institución Educativa San Pedro Claver

We improved the facilities of the San Pedro Claver educational institution in the town of Dagua by painting walls and floors and generally making the premises more attractive, creating relationships of credibility and trust with the communities in the project's area of influence.



#### Agua Segura Para Mi Gente Rural: clay water filters

We provided the most vulnerable educational institutions along the Buenaventura - Loboguerrero - Buga road with a drinking water storage and treatment system, improving access to safe, clean drinking water by strengthening the management of safe drinking water and promoting innovative systems.



#### Centro de Atención a la Primera Infancia de Loboguerrero

The project helped to improve the facilities of the Day Care Center in the municipality of Dagua in the village of Loboguerrero, providing basic sanitation and materials for the center.





#### Coral restoration, "Ever-Living Coral"

We contribute to the restoration of marine ecosystems on Baru Island. By planting 100,000 corals, we seek to generate new marine ecosystems and to generate strategies through ecotourism for conservation, environmental education and local development that contribute to the sustainability of the project.



#### Repowering of a water treatment plant

We repowered the drinking water plant of the Correa aqueduct in the municipality of María La Baja, providing drinking water. The aim of this project is to implement corrective measures that will help to ensure the renewed supply of drinking water for the inhabitants of Correa.



#### Improving the electrical and septic system at El Colegio del Cuerpo

The project aims to contribute to the installation of electrical and septic systems so that residences can be made operational. It will also make it possible to provide electricity to educational spaces.







#### Waste Transfer and Material **Recovery Facility**

We have set up a waste transfer and material recovery facility in Pasacaballos. The project is aimed at strengthening organizations of waste pickers' and collectors, improving their living conditions and enhancing their economic activity by providing them with the appropriate tools to help them generate more income and profitability.



#### Photovoltaic panels to ensure access to energy

We have collaborated on the installation of photovoltaic panels to guarantee access to energy for the inhabitants of Reges Island in the municipality of Arjona. The project aims to use photovoltaic panels to generate energy so that communities can improve their quality of life.



#### Fundación Mi Parque

With the "Patios Educativos" (playgrounds) project, we are improving the quality of life of vulnerable communities through a participatory process of design, construction and activation of green areas to bring people together.







#### **CEAZA**

We collaborated on this project which aims to promote the protection and conservation of coastal wetlands through environmental education. The aim is to increase awareness and knowledge of the importance of these ecosystems, as well as to encourage responsible attitudes and actions towards their preservation.



#### **TECHO-Chile Project**

For two days, we enjoyed a new corporate volunteering experience with TECHO-Chile thanks to the work and willingness of the Sacyr Water team in the Metropolitan Region. Over these two days, almost thirty workers took part in this voluntary work, the aim of which was to provide two temporary homes to families in the municipality of Lampa.







#### Salesian Missions

We have facilitated access to vocational training for vulnerable young people with physical disabilities in Piura, Peru, expanding their opportunities to develop socio-occupational skills with an environmental approach.






#### Fundación Peruana de Cáncer

We helped build and equip two multi-purpose modules in the Frieda Heller hostel to attend to cancer patients from all over Peru and their families, proving nutrition, mental health and physical therapy consultations.







#### Make a Wish Peru

We supported an inter-company padel tennis championship in which Sacyr participated. This initiative helped to make the wishes of children and teenagers with serious illnesses come true.







#### Plantando Futuro

We planted native trees that help combat climate change and conserve soils, fresh water reserves and biodiversity. We also contributed to educational workshops and talks, campaigns to raise environmental awareness and awareness about endangered animals, and helped buy kits to fight forest fires in Cajamarca.



#### Fundación Pachacútec

We work with this organization dedicated to education, social development and the inclusion of communities in vulnerable situations by supporting the purchase of sports and educational equipment and material. Its main mission is to support young people and adults, mainly in rural and peripheral areas, through education, training and skills development programs to improve their quality of life and help them get access to better job opportunities.



#### Casa Ronald McDonald

Casa Ronald McDonald is a temporary home for children, teenagers and their families who must travel to Lima so that their child can receive the medical treatment they require for their complex illness. We helped to provide a room at the center.



#### El Rastrillo 305 in Miami

We collaborated with El Rastrillo 305, an initiative that aims to promote culture, community engagement and social awareness. All proceeds from this charity event have gone to support socio-educational projects for underprivileged children in the Miami area.





#### Texas High School Rodeo

We collaborated with scholarships designated for senior THSRA members to fund their further academic or technical training. The aim is to encourage young people in the countryside to stay in school and complete their studies.





#### **Grace Campus Texas**

We support this organization through Grace Campus, a transitional shelter for homeless people. We provide users with support to meet their basic needs.

#### Fundación Inclusive

We collaborated on a project to install solar panels in the Rehabilitation Center for People in a Situation of Dependency, located in the town of Pinto. We improved its facilities by saving energy and reducing its carbon footprint. We also donated a van for the transport of users.







#### Fundación Juan XXIII

We helped to install kitchens at the Fundación Juan XXIII catering college in Madrid with the aim of promoting the social and occupational inclusion of people in situations of psychosocial vulnerability.






#### Asociación DogPoint

We collaborate with this association through a corporate volunteering program in which Sacyr professionals foster Labrador puppies for a year to support their training process on their path to becoming assistance puppies for children with autism, reducing runaway behaviour and frustration, stimulating communication and providing security for the whole family.









#### Red Acoge

We help change the situation of migrants and refugees, enabling greater integration into the job market through training and practical classes. We provide training to migrants in vulnerable situations and at risk of social exclusion, especially women.







#### Fundación Abracadabra

We ran "Magic therapy" workshops in residences for the elderly and disabled together with Sacyr workers. We also had a performance by a magician for hospitalised people at the Hospital Universitario Infanta Cristina in Parla.





#### Adopta un Abuelo

We collaborated on three volunteer projects with the elderly. One of them consists of making regular phone calls to people who are lonely, creating a very special bond. We also attended a game of bingo at one residence and supported the activity "My grandparents are awesome".







#### Fundación Exit

We collaborate on the "Coach" project, supporting young people in situations of social vulnerability; and "EXplora", a voluntary project that involves recording video interviews or clips to show the work carried out by the chosen professional and/or department.





#### Fundación ANDE

We carried out voluntary work to renovate the gardens and allotments at the San Fernando Occupational Center of Fundación ANDE, a center that cares for people with intellectual disabilities, providing rehabilitation, personal and social empowerment, personal care and specialised assistance, so they may achieve the maximum development of their abilities and possibilities for social integration.





#### Fundación Jero García

We collaborated with Sport vs Bullying, an innovative and vital program to eradicate bullying in schools. Through the powerful testimonies of athletes who experienced bullying at school, we worked with young people, encouraging empathy and educating them about the importance of respect and solidarity in the school setting. We also held a volunteer boxing event together with a talk on bullying for workers and their families.

#### **Aldeas Infantiles**

We collaborated with the "Emergencia en casa" (Emergency at home) project, which consists of providing financial support through monthly vouchers to families in situations of vulnerability, in order to cover their basic needs.







#### Fundación Salud Infantil Elche

This foundation offers interdisciplinary care to children aged 0-16 who are born with a disability or at risk of disability. We collaborate with physiotherapy and speech therapy services for newborn babies at biological and/ or social risk who are susceptible to some form of functional diversity and in need of early intervention servic-



#### Fundación Amoverse

Through the "Soy Cometa" (I'm a Kite) campaign, we provide young people in neighbourhoods, families and contexts of social exclusion with the possibility of enjoying a summer camp, with healthy leisure activities and educational development in values with positive social relations.





#### Asociación Infantil Oncológica de Madrid - ASION

We collaborated with ASION's summer camp run for children with cancer. We worked to support the special psychosocial needs of children with cancer and their siblings, such as acceptance of the consequences of the disease, self-esteem, problem solving, autonomy, social integration, etc. through this summer camp.







# Fundación Meridional, **Baby Despensa**

We support the "Baby Despensa" (Baby Pantry) project located in Pozo del Tío Raimundo (Puente de Vallecas, Madrid) for the weekly distribution of milk, baby food and nappies, offering these free food and care products for children from 0 to 3 years old to families who are particularly vulnerable and fragile.





# Fundación Ronald **McDonald**

We collaborate through the Ronald McDonald rooms created for sick children and their companions. They offer a place for rest and privacy within the hospital itself. They provide a quiet place for families to recharge, eat, shower or rest during long days of testing or treatment. We ran a cookie-making workshop for patients undergoing treatment at the Hospital Niño Jesús.



### Mamás en acción

We support sick children who are alone in hospitals, providing support and affection to hospitalised children in vulnerable situations.

#### Fundación Blue Life

We support the foundation's project aimed at the protection and recovery of Mediterranean marine ecosystems, especially focused on the Posidonia oceanica meadows, coral beds and other species catalogued as unique, vulnerable and endangered in Ibiza. This project directly contributes to the preservation of these crucial habitats for a wide variety of marine species, as well as to climate regulation and improved water quality.



### Seo BirdLife - Gaiambiente

We ran a workshop in the Region of Madrid on the construction and placement of nest boxes in trees for small birds (passerines).







## Saving the Amazon

We contribute to the reforestation of the Amazon by planting trees and building a corporate forest. Through this Geoforest link, you can geolocate all the trees planted in the Sacyr Forest in the Amazon.

We contribute to the growth of this forest by planting specimens of 514 different species. In addition to the 1,254 trees already planted in 2023, we planted a further 800 more over the course of 2024 in the Colombian Amazon.



#### Buceo Melilla

We organised a seabed litter pick together with Asociación Buceo Melilla, with more than 60 volunteers, in the marine environment of Aguadú and Horcas Coloradas in Melilla. This initiative, which has been running for the past 10 years, led to the removal of 450 kg of waste on this occasion.





#### Universidad de Navarra

We collaborated on the #LabMeCrazy! Science Film Festival project, an initiative launched by the Universidad de Navarra Science Museum to bring science closer to young people. The aim of #LabMeCrazy! Science Film Festival is to spark curiosity and transmit a passion for science, bringing together the best audiovisual productions to help you enter the world of science, from a new approach, tailor-made for you.

Our Sacyr Band gave a charity concert at a venue in Madrid where the audience enjoyed music and lively conversation with colleagues, friends and family.



We ran a charity auction for an acoustic guitar donated by a Sacyr colleague and signed by Gonzalo Valdivia, the guitarist with Héroes del Silencio.





We held our internal "weRSoCial" meeting with Fundación FITA, an organization that specialises in eating disorders.



We organised a great day of sports activities (zip wires and archery) and a Master Chef competition at Fundaland.





We presented awards to our most committed Sacyr voluteers and also the foundations that we collaborate with the most. Pedro Alonso, Executive Director of the Sacyr Foundation, was in charge of presenting the awards.

# **Charity Markets**




# Recognition on World Autism Day with DogPoint

# Supporting the Asociación Debra Piel de Mariposa

Sacyr employees gave their support to the charity organization Debra Piel de Mariposa that supports children with butterfly skin. First of all, there was a campaign to collect clothes, shoes, bags, toys and other items, which reached 100 kg of donations. These items were donated to the Debra charity shops in Madrid and Seville. In addition, 14 bags containing mainly new or semi-new toys and home decoration items were also collected and sold in these charity shops. The aim of these actions was to give visibility to this rare disease on Rare Disease Day (28 February) and to contribute to the work of the charity organization, which supports more than 300 families.
